#### THE FOUNDATIONS OF PRAYER

## SAMPLE PROGRAMME

March 20th 2021

**Invitation to Prayer in the Carmelite Tradition (live-presentation)** 

**PRACTICE:** Central themes of Carmelite prayer

**Spiritual conversation:** responding to some Carmelite statements on prayer – what speaks? Challenges? How would I express it? Collective concerns and opportunities for Carmelite prayer in pastoral settings.

Workshop: planning a guided meditation.

**Task for next session**: opening up Carmelite images of God for others.

**April 3rd 2021** 

Personality, Experiences and Prayer (video lecture)

**PRACTICE:** A Carmelite approach to meditation

Spiritual conversation: Carmelite imagery of God.

Workshop: opening up these images for others.

**Task for next session**: how would I introduce a Carmelite approach to meditation?

May 15th 2021

**Drawing from the Wellsprings of Scripture (live-presentation)** 

**PRACTICE:** Biblical roots of Carmelite prayer and *lectio divina* 

**Spiritual conversation:** looking for Christ in Scripture.

**Workshop**: leading a guided meditation on the theme of desert/waiting

**Task for next session**: introducing and leading a *lectio* session.

June 26th 2021

A Learning Hidden Deep in the Heart: Reflections from *The Third Spiritual Alphabet*, Guide of St Teresa (video lecture)

**PRACTICE:** Disposing oneself for the gift of contemplation

**Spiritual conversation**: how is prayer a battle for the heart? what disposes the heart for a place of loving communion?

**Workshop**: introducing an exercise in the prayer of recollection in everyday life.

**Task for next session**: planning a session on "personal prayer and the Eucharist".

#### SAMPLE PROGRAMME

September 18th 2021

**Praying in the Company of Mary** 

**PRACTICE:** Living in the Company of Mary

Spiritual conversation: Mary, mother and sister: her place in my life.

Workshop: introducing a session on "praying with two Hebrew mothers" (Lk 1:46-55; cf. 1

Sam 2:1-10; Ps 113).

**Task for next session**: developing a meditation on Mary from a Carmelite perspective.

## **October 16th 2021**

Discerning Growth/Regression in Prayer

**PRACTICE:** Discerning Growth and Regression

**Spiritual conversation**: beginning to think about quiet days and retreats for growth in our prayer life.

**Workshop**: continuing to reflect on my experience as a participant in a day of recollection; a retreat; a time of guided prayer.

**Task for next session**: Beginning to think about planning quiet days and retreats.

## October 30th 2021

Feelings, Mystical Experiences and Prayer

**PRACTICE:** Feelings, Locutions and Experiences

**Spiritual conversation**: how do I respond to talk of 'favours', visions, locutions? How does Carmelite teaching affect this?

**Workshop**: brainstorming what is needed in planning a retreat day and how lessons drawn from prayers of Scripture and the saints can help enrich the experience.

**Task for next session**: Continuing to reflect on retreats: individually guided retreats and themed retreats.

# January 8th 2022

The Eucharist: Source and Summit of Prayer

**PRACTICE:** Living in Appreciative Abandonment.

**Spiritual conversation**: how can I listening more appreciatively to life? what are the obstacles and resistances to appreciative living? how do I live the Eucharist?

**Workshop:** Presenting a meditation on the mystery of the Trinity using brief Carmelite meditations.

Task for next session: Planning for the closing session.
